

FIREWORKS SAFETY


Fireworks can be a spectacular event but they can also explode and cause serious injuries. The best way to stay safe is to attend a public fireworks display.



Use these simple tips to help keep your family and home safe:



Children should always let adults light fireworks.




Light one firework at a time and don't relight a dud.



Use only legal fireworks, and never try to make your own.



Have a safety plan. Keep a bucket of water or hose handy in case of an accident. Soak all fireworks in water before throwing them away.



Fireworks should only be lit outside. Sparklers should be used with caution, and kept away from face, hair and clothing.



Keep a safe distance from fireworks and point fireworks away from home to avoid injuries and fires.
