

REAR FACING CAR SEAT



1

Always read the vehicle owner's manual and the car seat instructions before installation. Your child must meet the height and weight requirements of the seat.

**2**

Once installed, push and pull at **belt path** to ensure that the base (or car seat) doesn't move more than 1".

**5**

Harness straps should fit snugly. You should not be able to pinch any extra material at the straps.

**3**

Ensure that the car seat is installed at the correct angle, indicated by an angle indicator or horizontal arrow on the side of the car seat.

**6**

Do not place toys and mirrors close to the car seat. These can injure a child in an accident.

**4**

Harness straps must be flat, at or below the child's shoulders and buckled. Chest clip must be at armpit level.

**7**

Babies **MUST** be rear-facing until age 2. Always ensure your child is within the maximum height and weight requirements of the seat.
