

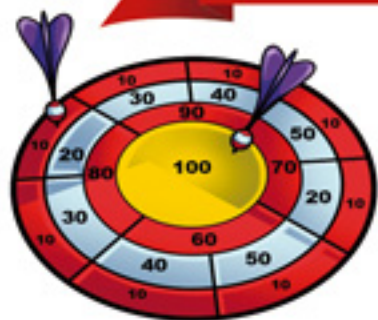

When buying a toy for your child:



- 1** Watch out for toys that can be propelled, and that have sharp edges.



- 2** Watch out for toys with long strings, cords, loops or ribbons, and keep away from cribs and playpens.



- 3** If a child can enter a toy, like a tent, it should be properly built so that the child can breath comfortably.



- 4** If a toy has moveable parts, make sure they don't jam or trap a child's finger.

- 5** Read and follow warning labels, and check electric toys that may cause shock or burn.

- 6** Be cautious of toys that have batteries and magnets, which can cause fatal injury if swallowed.



- 7** Look out for small parts, such as balloons or plastic wrap, which can cause choking or suffocation hazards.
